

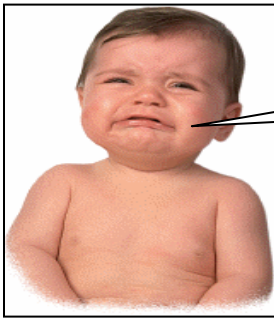
What if I don't like the score I received on stage 3 – 4 test?



I guess we can give these revision things a try....

1. If you more than 15 points on the exam, you have until our next class meeting to write a revision of your test. If you miss the deadline, your score will remain at the number recorded on test.

- a. A revision to your exam must meet the following criteria:
 - Revisions will be typed
 - First find the item that you missed and restate the question/problem
 - Next, write your original response
 - Finally, explain why it is wrong and correct it.
 - b. If you missed 15 or more points on the test and are pursuing this opportunity to improve your score, the best grade possible for this scenario is 68 points (“B” grade). These points will be awarded entirely on the basis of quality of your revisions and the effort that is evident.
2. If you missed fewer than 15 points on the exam, but would still like to improve your score, you may also complete a revision but the maximum amount of bonus points in this scenario is +4 (%5 bonus)
 3. Additional points beyond the revisions may be earned if you produce and submit note cards for all vocabulary stages 1 - 5 by the next class. Points will be awarded at teacher’s discretion, who will evaluate the note cards on the criteria of the effort evident in making your cards and how useful they will be as a tool for learning vocabulary.
