V. ADJECTIVE GAME

1. Students follow instructions to play game
2. They move around room drawing adjectives and nouns then writing them down on a score sheet
3. First student to get 5 adjective/noun pairs right gets 5 bonus points to today's vocab quiz

VI. EXTRA TIME

1. Discuss medicine and science at Alexandria:
2. Alexandria, with library and wealth became a center of attraction for many scholars
3. Hippocrates: medical science. Interesting in finding causes of diseases and health problems. Read oath from p. 176
4. Herophilus: Anatomy. First recorded human dissection. Surgery a regular practice. Strong insistence on hygiene, exercise, regular diet
5. Eratosthenes: By using shadows from sticks at different latitudes, calculated circumference of earth 24,662 (actual 24,680). Idea suggested that the earth was round; they also made measurements between earth and sun – without telescopes
6. Hero of Alexandria: steam power; mechanized robots; pulleys, pumps, screws, siphons, valves used widely
7. In sum: fantastically advanced, more than most would suspect
