

### EXPRESSING TIME FOR INDICATIVE CLAUSES

Present infinitive	shows	SAME TIME as main verb
Perfect infinitive	shows	TIME BEFORE main verb
Future infinitive	shows	TIME AFTER main verb

Example: Discipulī Magīstrum canem esse dicunt.

### EXPRESSING TIME FOR SUBJUNCTIVE CLAUSES (SEQUENCE OF TENSES)

Main verb (**INDICATIVE**)

Use this **SUBJUNCTIVE** in the dep. clause to show *time*

PRIMARY	Present	1. Present	shows	same time
	Future	2. Perfect	shows	time before
	Future Perfect (Present Perfect)	3. FAP + sim	shows	time after
	(Imperative)

SECONDARY	Imperfect	1. Imperfect (pres. inf. + pers. ending)	shows	same time
	Perfect	2. Pluperfect (perf inf. + pers ending)	shows	time before
	Pluperfect	3. FAP + essem (-ūrus, a, um)	shows	time after

Main verb (**INDICATIVE**)
