

PROBATIO I: What to expect

GENERAL: 4 sections – Vocabulary, Translation and reading, Grammar and Short answer.

VOCABULARY: 10 words, 5 have been taken from the previous two quizzes, the other 5 have not yet appeared on a quiz

TRANSLATION AND READING: Includes two passages. One prepared passage and one sight passage. Each passage will have questions about the grammar concepts you have seen on the quizzes.

GRAMMAR: Using passages from as early as ch. 58 and also from other activities, this section will ask you two additional grammar questions.

SHORT ANSWER: For this section of the test, you will turn in the section you have been working on in exchange for a sheet of paper with the following question written on it:

Using your text book (or the Catullus handouts), find two examples where any of the authors we have read uses the structure of the Latin language to reinforce the message that he is trying to convey. Each example **MUST** be accompanied by specific Latin evidence as discussed on Monday.
